## Ann B. Barshinger Cancer Institute



**Ann B. Barshinger Cancer Institute Fund** – Supports the advancement of cancer care at the Cancer Institute including research, patient care and education, community programs and services.

**James & Sally Saxton Pastoral Care Fund** – Provides comprehensive spiritual and emotional support to oncology patients and their families. Gifts fund the education and training of an advanced-practice fellowship in oncology.

**LG Health Cancer Support Fund** – Provides a financial safety net for cancer patients in need of assistance to help pay for daily living expenses such as uncovered medical expenses, prescriptions, transportation to treatment as well as help with day-to-day expenses such as rent, food and utilities.

**Rita Bonchek Cancer Care Fund** – Addresses the unique needs of women living with cancer by providing financial assistance to these patients to purchase wigs, hats, pressure garments and other personal care products to help with restoring their self-esteem and sense of well being.

**Survivorship & Supportive Services Endowment** – Initiated by a leadership gift provided by the United Auxiliaries to Lancaster General Hospital, this fund provides support to address the physical, spiritual and psychosocial needs of cancer patients at diagnosis. This helps to empower cancer patients during their transition from treatment to everyday living.

## Lancaster Heart & Vascular Institute

**Lancaster Heart & Vascular Institute Fund** – Supports the advancement of cardiac care for patients, cardiac research and community outreach and education programs.

**Richard H. Mann, MD, Cardiology Endowment** – Supports the advancement of research and cardiology treatment.

**Women's Heart Health Fund** – Provides lectures, educational materials and promotes activities that are designed with a woman's heart in mind.



## Lancaster General Hospital Endowment & Special Purpose Funds

**Clinical Pastoral Education Fund** – Provides funding for residency positions in the Pastoral Services area.

**The Essa E. Flory Renal Dialysis Fund** – Supports education and training for the renal dialysis staff, patient care and education materials for dialysis patients.

**Area of Greatest Need** – This unrestricted fund helps minimize the need for tuition increases, subsidizes faculty development and supports technology improvements.

## Women & Babies Hospital & Women's Health Special Purpose Funds



**Butterfly Fund** – Provides educational materials to parents who have suffered a loss, memorial gifts so children can be honored, and help to families with burial costs.

**Butterfly Endowment Fund** – Endowment to build a sustainable funding source for the Butterfly Fund (see above). This fund will ensure that the Butterfly Fund will be in existence in perpetuity to support families at WBH.

**Carter's Corner Fund** – Provides craft supplies, toys and books for this dedicated play space for children.

**NICU Fund** – Provides amenities for NICU families, books and videos for siblings, and specialized medical equipment for our tiniest patients.

**Red Wagon Fund** – Used to support the areas of greatest need at WBH including car seats for families who cannot afford them and specialized pieces of equipment.

**The Dr. John C. May Memorial Fund** – Provides financial assistance to nurses employed by Women & Babies Hospital to further their education related to obstetric and gynecological care.

**Women's Giving Circle** – Women leveraging their contributions to fund projects specific to Lancaster General Health Women & Babies Hospital and women's health initiatives (a minimum \$250 gift is required).
