You are being invited to volunteer to participate in a research study Changing Physicians' Perceptions on Opioid Abuse Management Using Continuing Medical Education conducted by Dr. Peggy Nepps with the Penn Medicine Lancaster General Health CME Department. The purpose of this research is to determine if CME training on opioid abuse management changes perceptions about addiction. The study will involve completion of a 12 question survey before and after the program, which should take no more than 5 minutes. We will also ask four demographic questions. You do not need to participate in the study to complete the CME program. There are no benefits, costs, or risks to you from participation, although your information may help us to provide more effective CME in the future.

The identifying information collected by eeds will only be used for CME credit and as proof of your completion of the training. Your responses to the research survey questions will be de-identified before data analysis so that your name will not be associated with them in any way. Data will be kept on a secure server and only presented or published in aggregate form and may be used in future research.

You have the right to ask any questions you may have about this research. If you have questions, complaints or concerns or believe you may have been harmed from participating in this research, you should contact Dr. Peggy Nepps at 717-544-4940. The Human Research Protection Program (HRPP) provides oversight of all research activities involving human subjects at Lancaster General Health.
