LGH Hospitalists' Surge - Crisis Plan

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LGH Med-Surg. Floors & Capacity Chart

- ▶ Teams will be assigned Geographic units as much as possible.

LGH Hospitalists' Surge / Crisis Plan – Principles

- ▶ Geographically based Teams and each team composed of:
 - One Hospitalists Physician
 - Hospitalists APC
 - For Crisis 1 Plan: Add Tier 1 Outpatient PCP or Subspecialist
 - For Crisis 2 Plan: Add Tier 2 Outpatient PCP or Subspecialist
- ▶ Week on/off Rounding and Week on/off Admitting Services
- ▶ F&CM Attending with Residents & GIM Group will participate
- ▶ Back-up Plans included for Provider illness & Quarantine

Hospitalists' Current Capacity – Managing up to **320** Patients

- ▶ Current Capacity per day (Including Obs) IMHs (240 pts) & GIM (60 pts):
 - Rounders: 9 Physicians + 9 APCs = 18 Rounders + 3 **GIM** Rounders = **21**
 - Admitters (over 24 hours): 6 Physicians + 7 APCs + 1 **GIM** Admitter = **14**
- ▶ Rounding Shifts: 10 hours each day – Week on/off
- ▶ Night Admitting Shifts: 12 hours for Night Physicians and
10 hours for Night APCs
- ▶ **F&CM** Residency Service ~ **20** patients per day.

Initial Surge Plan (starts with **Med-staff date**)- Up to **360** Pts.

2 more Week-on/off Rounding Teams added from **F&CM**:
Total **10** IMHs Teams

- Each Team up to 32 Patients = 320

GIM Team Rounding changes:
2 Rounders + 1 12p-10p Admitter
Week On/Off (including wkends)

- Managing 40 patients

Each IMHs Team will have One Physician + One APC rounder
The two F&CM Attending teams will have residents instead of APCs
GIM Physicians will continue their service as it is for this initial surge

2 more IMHs Admitters will be added: 9a-7p & 7p-7a Nocturnist

Each day: Total Rounding Providers: **22** Total Admitting Providers: **16**
That means for Week on/off model: Total Rounders: 44, Total Admitters: 32

Hospitalists Surge Team- Crisis Level 1 – Up to **480** Patients

Combining IMHs +F&CM + GIM

12 Rounding Teams (Each team with **40** patients)– Structure of Each team below:
(Note: Structure for F&CM Teams will be different: 2 F&CM Attendings + Residents)

Hospitalist Physician

- Managing up to 10 Pts + supervision

Hospitalist APC

- Managing up to 15 Patients

Non-Hospitalist Tier 1
(Outpt PCP or Subspecialist)

- Managing up to 15 Patients

4 more Admitters added: 7a-5p, 12p-10p, 9p-7a & 2p-12a

Each day: Total Rounding Providers: **36** Total Admitting Providers: **20**
That means for Week on/off model: Total Rounders: 72, Total Admitters: 40

Hospitalists Surge Team- **Crisis Level 2** – Up to **660** Patients

12 Rounding Teams Combining IMHs + GIM
(each with 55 pts) – Structure of Each team:

Hospitalist Physician

- Managing up to 10 Pts. + Supervision

Hospitalist APC

- Managing up to 15 Patients

Non-Hospitalist Tier 1
(Outpt PCP or Subspecialist)

- Managing up to 15 Patients

Non-Hospitalist Tier 2
(Outpt PCP or Subspecialist)

- Managing up to 15 Patients

6 more Admitters added: 9a-7p, 7a-5p, 7p-7a, 12p-10p, 9p-7a, 2p-12a

Total Rounding Providers: **48** Total Admitting Providers: **25**
That means for Week on/off model: Total Rounders: 96, Total Admitters: 50

Hospitalists Surge – Worst Case Scenario – Up to **825** Patients

Adding **3** more Teams
15 Rounding Teams (each with 55 pts) – Structure of Each team:

Hospitalist Physician

- Managing up to 10 Pts. + Supervision

Hospitalist APC

- Managing up to 15 Patients

Non-Hospitalist Tier 1
(Outpt PCP or Subspecialist)

- Managing up to 15 Patients

Non-Hospitalist Tier 2
(Outpt PCP or Subspecialist)

- Managing up to 15 Patients

5 more Admitters added: 9a-7p, 12p-10p, 7a-5p, 7p-7a, 2p-12a

Total Rounding Providers: **60** Total Admitting Providers: **30**
That means for Week on/off model: Total Rounders: 120, Total Admitters: 60



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
